## MUST and MUSTN'T (necessity)

Must	Mustn't (Must not)
<p>Use <b>must</b> when you mean 'have to' do something – and it is very important to do it.</p> <p>Examples:</p> <p>(1) "I <b>must</b> study for the test."</p> <p>(2) "You <b>must</b> wear a seatbelt."</p>	<p>Use <b>mustn't</b> when you mean that it is important NOT to do something.</p> <p>Examples:</p> <p>(1) "You <b>mustn't</b> forget about the test."</p> <p>(2) "You <b>mustn't</b> drive too fast."</p>
